HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Maui FCU will award at five (5) \$1,000 associate, baccalaureate or graduate degree scholarships for the Fall 2022 term for a total of \$5,000.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To apply, an applicant must be:

- A Maui FCU primary member in good standing¹ for at least a year prior to the deadline for submitting the scholarship application (must be a member as of May 31, 2021) and must continue to be a primary member at the time the scholarship is awarded.
- Enrolled in an associate, baccalaureate or graduate degree program at an accredited college or university.
- Attendance must be on a full-time² basis during the award year. Proof of enrollment required.

Note: To provide opportunities for all members, the Maui FCU member scholarship is restricted to one award per member per lifetime.

- 1 Member is current with all obligations outstanding with Maui FCU and has not caused the Credit Union a loss. Parental membership does not qualify applicant. All applicants must themselves be a member of a participating credit union.
- 2 Full-time is defined by the specific college or university. For example, the University of Hawaii requires a minimum of 12 credits per semester for full-time status in undergraduate programs.

The terms and conditions of this scholarship program may be subject to change or termination without prior notice.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applications must be complete and all documents received no later than June 1, 2022 at 11:59 PM. Mailed applications must be postmarked by June 1, 2022. Incomplete applications will not be considered. No exceptions.
- Applicants must be a graduating high school senior, a high school graduate or have obtained a GED certificate who plan to further their education as a full-time student at an institution of higher learning (college or university) or who are full-time students at such institution of higher learning who are pursuing a degree (associate, baccalaureate or graduate degree). If you meet these qualifications, you may be eligible to receive a scholarship.
- Selection will be made by random drawing based on all eligible and qualified scholarship applications.
- Finalists will be notified by phone no later than July 15, 2022.
- Acceptance of the Maui FCU member scholarship constitutes permission to use recipient's name, photo, essay and/or video for purposes of advertising and promotion by the credit union and its agencies.

SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT & DISCLOSURE



Applicant must submit **ONE** of the following:

- Essay: 600-or-fewer words based on this topic: "As a credit union member, explain why someone should choose Maui FCU as their primary financial institution over alternative service providers, such as for profit banks."
- Video: Create a 60 second video showing how Maui FCU is helping families achieve their financial goals. Video must be uploaded to YouTube and URL link to video must be supplied on scholarship application.

*MAKE SURE THAT YOUR YOUTUBE VIDEO IS NOT SET TO "PRIVATE" VIEWING.

• **Photo:** Capture an <u>original</u> photograph (taken by the applicant) that represents how Maui FCU is helping families financially. Along with your photo, include a title and a short description of your photo. Photo must be printed and uploaded to Google Drive. The URL link to the photo must be supplied on application.

Submission must address the topic and must not have been submitted to any other competition or contest. All submissions become the property of Maui Federal Credit Union.
