HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- ² Full-time is defined by the specific college or university. For example, the University of Hawaii requires a minimum of 12 credits per semester for full-time status in undergraduate programs.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Applications must be complete and all documents received no later than June 1st. Incomplete applications will not be considered. No exceptions.
- 2. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior, a high school graduate or have obtained a GED certificate who plan to further their education as a full-time student at an institution of higher learning (college or university) or who are full-time students at such institution of higher learning who are pursuing a degree (associate, baccalaureate or graduate degree). If you meet these qualifications, you may be eligible to receive a scholarship.
- 3. Selection will be made by random drawing.
- 4. Finalists will be notified by phone no later than July 15th.
- Acceptance of the Maui FCU member scholarship constitutes permission to use recipient's name, photo, essay and/or video for purposes of advertising and promotion by the credit union and its agencies.

Note: To provide opportunities for all members, the Maui FCU member scholarship is restricted to one award per member per lifetime.
