

MauiFed is committed to improving the financial lives of our members. Our financial resources for young adults and the annual Scholarship Program were created to help members with early financial milestones, like going to college.

MauiFed will award at five (5) \$1,000 associate, baccalaureate or graduate degree scholarships for the Fall 2025 term for a total of \$5,000.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- A MauiFed primary member in good standing<sup>1</sup> for at least 9 months before the deadline (which means being a member of June 30, 2024) to submit the scholarship application and must remain a primary member when the scholarship is awarded.
- Enrolled in an associate, baccalaureate or graduate degree program at an accredited college or university.
- Attendance must be on a full-time<sup>2</sup> basis during the award year.

<sup>1</sup>Member is current with all obligations outstanding with MauiFed and has not caused the credit union a loss. Parental membership does not qualify applicant. All applicants must be a primary member of MauiFed.

<sup>2</sup>Full-time is defined by the specific college or university. For example, the University of Hawaii requires a minimum of 12 credits per semester for full-time status in undergraduate programs.

**Note:** To provide opportunities for all members, the MauiFed member scholarship is restricted to one award per member per lifetime.

#### **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

 Completed scholarship application must be received via online application, email, main branch drop-off, or mail by April 30, 2025, at 11:59 PM.
